## **Art.1 - Notice of Competition**

The competition is open to young musicians of both sexes and of any nationality.

## **Art.2 - Section Categories and Evidence**

- Section I:** Piano
- Section II:** Strings
- Section III:** Wind instruments
- Section IV:** Harp
- Section V:** Chamber Music (*from duo to quintet, including piano 4 hands, pianistic duo excluded*)

**Categories : Piano, Strings, Wind instruments, Harp (section I, II, III, IV)**

**Cat. J)** up to 8 year old born from 2011 onwards - Maximum duration of execution 6 minutes;

**Cat. A)** up to 10 year old – born in the years 2010-09 - Maximum duration of execution 8 minutes;

**Cat. B)** up to 13 years old – born in the years 2008-07-06 - Maximum duration of execution 10 minutes;

**Cat. C)** up to 16 years old – born in the years 2005-04-03 - Maximum duration of execution 14 minutes;

**Cat. D)** up to 19 years old – born in the years 2002-01-00 - Maximum duration of execution 16 minutes;

**Cat. E)** up to 22 years old – born in the years 1999-98-97 - Maximum duration of execution 18 minutes;

**Cat. F)** up to 25 years old – born in the years 1996-95-94 - Maximum duration of execution 20 minutes;

**Categories: Chamber Music (section V)**

**Cat. A)** up to 15 years old-born from 2003 onwards - Maximum duration of execution 10 minutes;

**Cat. B)** up to 18 years old-born in the years 2003-02-01 - Maximum duration of execution 12 minutes;

**Cat. C)** up to 21 years-born in the years 2000-99-98 - Maximum duration of execution 14 minutes;

**Cat. D)** up to 24 years old-born in the years 1997-96-95 - Maximum duration of execution

16 minutes;

**Cat. E)** up to 27 years old-born in the years 1994-93-92 - Maximum duration of execution 18 minutes;

**Cat. F)** up to 30 years old-born in the years 1991-90-89 - Maximum duration of execution 20 minutes;

- For the sec. Chamber Music the average age of the group components will be consider.

### **Program section I, II, III, IV, V**

The execution program is free.

### **Art. 3 - Period of Testing**

The selections for the "Salieri Young Award", for the "Salieri Prize", for the "Salieri Chamber Music Prize" and for the "Enfant Prodige Laura Palmieri Award", will take place from 9th to 14th April 2019 with a calendar to be defined.

### **Art. 4 - Hearings**

Competitors will be admitted to the tests in alphabetical order. The tests schedule of the individual categories will be announced no later than March 25, 2019. All tests will be open to the public. The hearings and the awards ceremony will be held at the Theater "A. Salieri" and at the auditorium "Piccolo Salieri" in Legnago. The day and time of the hearings will NOT be communicated by the organization, but each candidate must inquire about his own convocation, visiting [www.concorsosalieri.com](http://www.concorsosalieri.com) or calling the Artistic Director Prof. Davide De Togni tel. +39 345 63 93 395. Participants must be present half an hour before the audition time for the call, any latecomers will not be admitted to the test. Before the audition, the competitors must give to the jury an identity document and 2 copies of the scores to perform.

### **Art. 5 - Commission**

The Selection Committee will be composed by Conservatory professors, music players, teachers and musicians of the major Italian and European music scene. The jurors will vote by secret ballot in hundredths. Jurors with teaching relationship or kinship with the candidates, must abstain from voting.

### **Art. 6 - Awards**

To candidates that obtain the highest score of not less than 98/100: Diploma of 1st overall prize and cup;

To candidates that obtain a score of at least 95/100: Diploma of 1<sup>st</sup> prize and medal;

To candidates that obtain a score of at least 90/100: Diploma of 2<sup>nd</sup> prize and medal;

To candidates that obtain a score of at least 85/100: Diploma of 3<sup>rd</sup> prize and medal;

All other competitors will be awarded a participation Diploma.

### **Scholarship "Giuseppe Magnani Young"**

In memory of the musician Giuseppe Magnani (musician of Legnago \*), *four* scholarships will be given of € 200,00 each, Diploma, Trophy and a Concert prize. The first prize will be awarded to the overall first prize of the category *J-A-B-C- section I, II, III, IV*, who will be standing out for technical and artistic qualities, excluding the winner of the Young Salieri Prize.

### **Scholarship "Giuseppe Magnani"**

In memory of the musician Giuseppe Magnani (musician of Legnago\*), *four* scholarships will be given of € 250,00 each, Diploma, Trophy and a concert prize. The first prize will be awarded to the overall first prize of the category *D-E-F section I, II, III, IV*, who will be standing out for technical and artistic qualities, excluding the winner of the Salieri Prize (*\* Prominent personality in the music scene of the first half of the twentieth century, author of a major biography of Antonio Salieri - from 1922 Director of the School of String Instruments "A. Salieri", where he taught to many qualified string players*).

### **Scholarship “Giuseppe Magnani Chamber Music”**

In memory of the musician Giuseppe Magnani, two scholarships will be given of € 400,00 each, Diploma, Trophy and a Concert. The prize will be awarded to two chamber groups that will have reported the highest score among the first absolute prizes, chosen from among all the categories of the sec. V, which will be distinguished by technical and artistic qualities.

### **Prize "Antonio Salieri Young"**

The Prize “Antonio Salieri Young” will be given to the best musician among winners of the scholarships "Giuseppe Magnani Young". The prize consists of a grant of € 800,00 (this prize cannot be combined with other prizes), a Diploma of Honour, a Plaque and a Concert at the New Montemezzi Auditorium of the Conservatory “F. E. Dall’Abaco” of Verona. The winner will be selected after a competition that will take place on Sunday, April 14th, 2019 at 17:00 at the Piccolo Salieri Auditorium, Legnago. At the end of the performances of the finalists, a jury will select the winner of the Prize. The winner of the Prize “Antonio Salieri Young” must participate, for the award to be valid, at the “Gala Concert”, that will be held in Legnago on the 14<sup>th</sup> April 2019 at 20.45 p.m. at the Salieri Theater.

### **Prize "Antonio Salieri "**

The Prize “Antonio Salieri” will be given to the best musician among winners of the scholarships "Giuseppe Magnani". The prize consists of a grant of € 2000,00 (this prize cannot be combined with other prizes), a Concert with the Orchestra "I Virtuosi Italiani", a Diploma of Honour, a Plaque. The winner will be selected after a “concert competition” that will take place on Sunday, April 14th , 2019 at 20:45 at Teatro Salieri, Legnago. At the end of the performances of the finalists, a jury will select the winner of

the Prize.

### **Prize “ Salieri Chamber Music ”**

According to the Jury, two Chamber Groups will be admitted to the final selection, chosen from among the first absolute prizes of Section V. They will compete for the "Salieri Chamber Music" Prize, which consists of a € 1000,00 Scholarship, Diploma of Honor , Plate and a Concert. The selection will take place Sunday, April 14, 2019 at 20:45 at the Teatro Salieri in concert form. At the end of the performances, a selected Jury will choose the winner of this Prize.

### **Prize Enfant Prodige "Laura Palmieri"**

The Award is open to young pianists soloists or 4 hands, selected from the cat. J-A-B which will be distinguished by technical / artistic quality. The winner will be awarded with a scholarship of € 500,00 (*offered by the Palmieri family*), a Diploma of Honor, a Plaque and the participation in a concert in the New Auditorium Montemezzi of the Conservatory "E. F. dall'Abaco" of Verona.

### **Prize “Enrico De Mori”**

The prize is addressed to the young pianist, selected among all the categories, which will be particularly distinguished in the execution of one or more excerpts from the piano repertoire of the ' 900. A scholarship of € 500,00 (kindly offered by the De Mori family), Diploma of Honor, Plaque and a Concert will be awarded.

### **Special Prizes**

The competitors that show a significant technical / artistic maturity in execution of one or more tracks, will be awarded with the following prizes:

\* Prize "Baroque"– Diploma – at the best performance of a song from the Baroque period;

- \* Prize "Classic Sonata" – Diploma – for the best performance of a Sonata of the Classical period;
- \* Prize "Romantic Music"– Diploma – for the best performance of a piece of the Romantic period;
- \* Prize "Virtuosity"– Diploma – for the best performance of a virtuoso piece or study;
- \* Prize "Music 900"– Diploma – for the best performance of a piece of the twentieth century;
- \* Prize Contemporary Music- Diploma- for the best performance of a contemporary piece (from 1950 to the present day);
- \* Prize "Enfant Prodige" – Diploma- to the competitor that will be standing out for technical and artistic qualities, selected in the category J-A-B (excluding Piano section).

### **Concerts Award "Special Prizes"**

The winners of the special prizes must perform a concert at the auditorium of the Mantua Conservatory during the summer season devoted to prestigious International Competitions, at Teatro Ristori in Verona and at Altolivenza Musical Festival.

### **Audio/video recording**

During the competition it will be possible to film the competitors. Competitors cannot claim any rights of remuneration for any audio and/or video relating to each stage of the competition and Concert Award. These recordings will remain the exclusive property of the School of Instruments "A. Salieri".

### **Art. 7 - Registration Fee**

Sections: I, II, III, IV € 60.00  
 Section: V € 40.00 (for each member of the group)

The solo instrumentalists may bring their

own accompanist, for which there is no entry fee. If they intend to take advantage of the official accompanist of the Competition, appointed by the School of Music "A. Salieri" send, at the time of registration, a surcharge of € 25,00 for categories JUNIOR, A, B or € 40,00 for categories C, D, E, F, and a copy of the pieces that they want to perform by email to: [concorsosalieri@gmail.com](mailto:concorsosalieri@gmail.com)

### **Art. 8 - Application for Registration**

The application form must be completed online, on the form prepared by the organization at [www.accademiasalieri.com](http://www.accademiasalieri.com) by March 15th 2019 with attached a copy of the payment of the registration fee, for the registration to be valid.

### **Art. 9 - Common rules**

The candidates can enroll in a class higher than their age and participate in several sections of the competition, but not in multiple categories within the same section. The candidates are not required to reach the maximum time set for their category, but the Commission can stop the execution if it exceeds the specified limits. The Commission can ask the candidates to repeat or stop the executions, if they believe it necessary. The judgment will be final in all cases.

### **Art. 10 - Final Rules**

The organization makes available to competitors only the piano. To rent any instrument, contact the store MUSICALMENTE in Legnago (info@musicalmente.com - phone +39 346 79 88 906). Registration to the competition implies full and unconditional acceptance of the rules contained in this regulation which could in the case of force majeure. The Competition organization does not assume responsibility for any damages of any kind to persons or objects during the event. For any dispute the Court of Verona has exclusive jurisdiction.

### **Art. 11 - Privacy**
